**Recap:** A Penn State victory did not look likely with the Nittany Lions down by 14 points early in the 2007 Valero Alamo Bowl.

However, Penn State scored 17 consecutive points in the second quarter before A&M's Matt Szymanski kicked a 38-yard field goal to tie the game at 17-17 late in the third quarter. The Nittany Lions took the lead for good with a TD run by Evan Royster and held off a fourth-and-goal attempt by Texas A&M late in the fourth quarter.

Penn State's Rodney Kinlaw won Offensive MVP honors after running for 143 yards on 21 carries and backup runner Royster finished with 65 on nine carries.

A bowl record crowd of 66,166 saw the Penn State 24-17 victory in person, while 4.1 million watched on ESPN. The viewership was less than half of the expected total as the NFL opted to broadcast the New England Patriots' attempt to become the first team since the 1972 Dolphins to finish the regular season undefeated on NFL Network, NBC and CBS.

Penn State later vacated this victory because of NCAA penalties.
